# HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCK #6



Unfinished block measures 12 1/2" square

## Cutting:

<u>White:</u> Cut six 4" squares and \*\*\*one 7-inch square-you will **NOT** need to cut the 7 inch square if you have the left over 7-inch HST block from last month's block. You will use the 7-inch HST in this block.

**Blue:** Cut six 4" squares and \*\*\*one 7" square-you will **NOT** need to cut the 7-inch square if you have the left over 7-inch HST block from last month's block.

## Step #1:

Place a 4" white square on top of each of the 4" blue squares, draw a diagonal line on the back side of each white square and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the middle line and press toward the blue side. Trim these blocks to measure 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Trim the 7-inch HST to measure 6  $\frac{1}{4}$ " square.





## Step #2

Lay out the blocks as shown.

## Step #3:

Sew blocks together into three rows and then sew the rows together to form the block.
