

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCK #7



Unfinished block measures $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " square

Cutting:

White: Cut five 4" squares

Red: Cut six 4" squares

Blue: Cut five 4" squares



Step #1:

Place a 4" white square on top of two (2) of the 4" blue squares and three (3) of the 4" red squares, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of each white square and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Place a red square on top of the remaining blue squares right sides together, draw a diagonal line and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut all of the blocks apart on the middle line and press toward the darker side. Trim the blocks to measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Step #2

Lay out the blocks as shown.

Step #3:

Sew blocks together into four rows and then sew the rows together to form the block.
